Background of Business: "One night while having dinner at 3rd and Spruce in West Reading, I got to thinking about 'MEN' and how many barbershops of the past have gone out of business. The idea hit me. As a guy in the beauty industry, I could visualize the future of a huge trend coming where more men begin getting salon services. Most of the barbershops had gone out of business so men had turned to the beauty salon. I started the first American Male salon in 1997 on Morgantown Road as a learning lab for Raylon's customers. It was a working salon and we invited our customers to spend a day learning how to attract more men into their salon, including marketing to men and catering to what men really want out of a grooming experience. The idea caught on and a few more American Male salons were opened in PA and NJ under a licensing agreement. Now nine years later, American Male has grown to 15 salons across the nation from Philadelphia to California. The most recent salon opened in Las Vegas."

Recent Innovations: American Male recently transformed itself into a franchise ensuring that every American Male salon will use the same formula of success to satisfy the grooming needs of every guy that walks through our door – every salon, everywhere. CNBC recently did a segment on American Male and men in the beauty industry – Hafetz made his national television debut on August 30.
